I graduated from Instrumentation Technology at NAIT in 1972, and worked for ESSO Resources for the next 18 years. During my time with ESSO I worked as Maintenance Technician, Construction Supervisor, Quality Assurance Technologist, and Computer Systems Specialist on many of ESSO's highest profile, leading-edge projects of the time. After a "golden hand shake" from them, I incorporated my company Electro Spection Polytechnics Corporation (ESP) and obtained service contracts with a number of major corporations.
