Criteria

- Must be a current C.E.T. in good standing
- Must have a minimum of six (6) years of relevant work experience - two (2) of these must be under direct supervision and control of a P.Eng. or P.Geo.
- Two (2) years of post-secondary education in areas that relate to engineering or geoscience
- Compliance with the ASET Continuing Professional Development Program
- Completion of the National Professional Practice Exam
- Review and approval by the ASET/APEGA Joint Board of Examiners

Once ASET has received your application form, fee and supporting documentation your application will be forwarded to the Joint Board of Examiners for review.

The decisions of the Joint Board of Examiners are sent out by mail to applicants within 4 weeks of the meeting date.

Applications will be kept active for a period of one year. Should the time frame exceed one year the applicant may be required to reapply.
