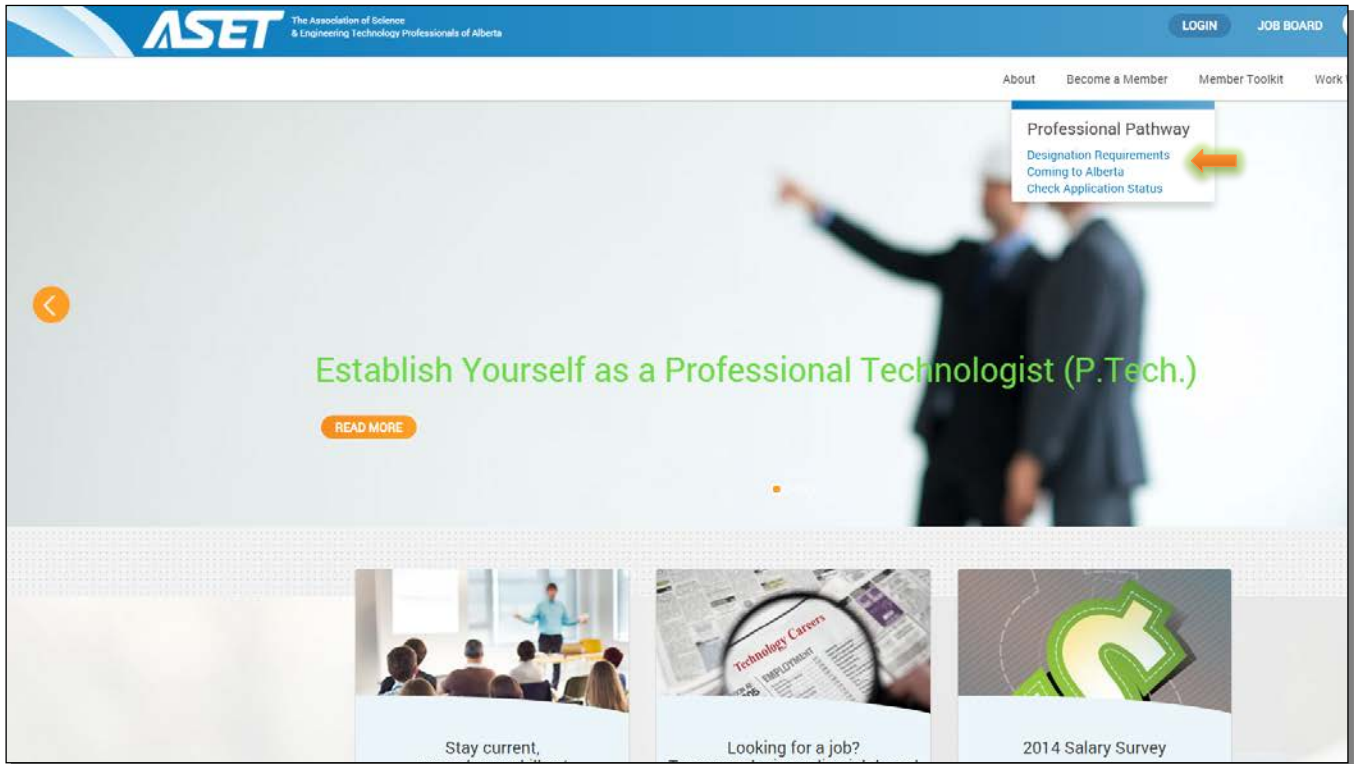

A **Certified Engineering Technologist (C.E.T.)** is an applied science, information, or engineering technology professional who is capable of assuming responsibility and exercising independent judgment to perform technical tasks and solve problems in complex technological areas with limited direct supervision.

****Non Graduate Applicants****

Please complete the *Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR)* if you are seeking registration with ASET but:

- Have not graduated from an applied science, engineering, or information technology program, or
- Are unable to produce academic transcripts

If you have graduated from an applied science, engineering or information technology program from **OUTSIDE** of Canada and can get, or have, a third party credential assessment (i.e. IQAS, WES, etc.), you are **NOT** required to complete the PLAR.
